All Saints' Vicarage

Further to my letter of 15 July 1967, I write to report that the Council of Jesus College has now confirmed the offer of £100 for the purchase by the College of an area of 115 square yards of the vicarage garden, subject to covenants

- (a) by the College, that the incumbent shall enjoy undisturbed use of the area for a period of 99 years; and
- (b) by the Church authorities, that they will not undertake any development, on a larger area between the vicarage and the College's proposed flats, that would include windows facing those flats.

The College undertakes to meet all legal fees and charges arising from this transaction, which it has also approved in principle in its capacity as Patron of the living of All Saints.

I should be glad to be informed when you have received the consent of the Church Commissioners to this transaction, so that the necessary formal documents can be drawn up and (in due course) sealed by the College and the Church authorities.

May I express my personal thanks for the very helpful way in which you have dealt with this matter? The friendly co-operation of the Church with the College has been most valuable to us and greatly appreciated.
