

RULES

³
Clapatt

1. The Society shall be composed of matriculated Members of Jesus College, Cambridge, and be called "THE JESUS COLLEGE CAMBRIDGE SOCIETY."

2. The objects of the Society shall be :—

(a) To encourage intercourse between old Jesus men, and to keep them in touch with the College and its doings.

(b) To publish and circulate amongst its Members an Annual Report, containing a list of Members with their addresses, and all news of interest about the doings of the present and former Members of the College.

(c) To ensure the permanence and success of the Jesus College Dinner, held annually in London on the first day of the Inter-University Cricket Match, and to pay the incidental expenses thereof.

(d) To forward the interests of any College institution.

3. Every matriculated Member of the College shall be eligible for election to the Society, and upon election

and payment of one guinea shall become a Member of the Society, without being liable to any further expense.

4. The Officers of the Society shall consist of a President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. The Master of the College shall be the President. In the event of a Vice-Master of the College being appointed, he shall become Vice-President. The Secretary and Treasurer shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

5. The management of the Society and the election of Members shall be vested in a Committee, consisting of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, two resident Fellows of the College nominated from time to time by the Master and Fellows, and sixteen elected members. At the Annual General Meeting one-fourth of the elected Members of the Committee shall retire from office. The retiring Members shall be those who have been longest in office since their last election, and amongst those of equal seniority the choice, in default of agreement, shall be made by ballot. The vacancies so created shall be filled up at the same Meeting by a majority of the votes of those present and voting. Casual vacancies may be filled up by the Committee, subject to confirmation at the next Annual General Meeting. A Member elected to fill a casual vacancy shall retire at the time when the Member whose place he fills would have retired.

6. The administration of the funds of the Society shall be vested in the Committee, who may invest or otherwise deal with the same for the objects of the Society as they in their discretion may think fit. All

investments shall be made in the names of three Trustees to be appointed by the Committee.

7. The Committee shall meet as and when they may from time to time determine; five to form a quorum.

8. The Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be held in London or Cambridge on a day to be fixed by the Committee. At least fourteen days' notice of the Meeting shall be given by the Secretary in such manner as the Committee shall from time to time direct.

9. The Annual Report, containing a list of Members with their addresses, and all news of interest about the doings of the present and former Members of the College, shall be edited by the two resident Fellows who are Members of the Committee, in conjunction with the Secretary, and shall be sent to every Member of the Society.

10. The Committee in their discretion may, and upon a written request signed by fifteen Members of the Society, shall call a Special General Meeting, the time and place for which shall be determined by the Committee. At least fourteen days' notice of such Meeting, stating the subject, shall be given in such manner as the Committee may direct.

11. If it appear to the Committee that the conduct of any Member of the Society is such as to render him unfit to remain a Member thereof, it shall be in their discretion to call a General Meeting to deal with the matter, and, in the event of its being decided at that

meeting by two-thirds of the Members present and voting that such Member be expelled from the Society, he shall thenceforth cease to be a Member, and forfeit all right to or claim upon the Society or its funds.

12. The Rules of the Society may be altered, but no alteration shall be made except at a General Meeting and by a majority of two-thirds of those present and voting, and unless notice of the proposed alteration has been stated on the notice calling the Meeting.

Report of the Events of the Year, 1930-1931.

Old Jesus men returning to Cambridge hardly recognise the College, so great is the change consequent upon the completion of the new buildings, and the acquisition of Butts Green. Chapel Court is now one of the finest courts in Cambridge, even rivalling in extent the Great Court of Trinity. The Close includes all the land up to Victoria Avenue, and an entrance to the College from Victoria Avenue has been made to take the place of the old Chapel Court entrance from Jesus Lane. The approach is through handsome iron gates, to be known henceforth as the Morgan Gates, which are the gift of the daughters of the late Master. On one side are Dr. Morgan's arms, and on the other the arms of the College. The same generous donors have offered to plant an avenue of trees from the gate to the Carpenter building in memory of Mrs. Morgan.

We have now had a year in which to test the practical qualities of the new buildings, and there is general agreement that they are admirable. The only serious criticism concerns their unexpected acoustic properties; owing perhaps to the excellence of the building, sound is transmitted rather freely from one room to another, so that the peace of the studious resident is more than usually dependent upon the habits of his neighbours. Last October, for the first time since the war, the great majority of the Freshmen were able to have rooms in College. We are greatly indebted to Mr. Manning, the Bursar, for the vast amount

of trouble he has taken over the buildings. In other days he and Mr. Morley Horder, the architect, might well have supported the Bishop's arms on the Western wall, instead of the somewhat Mongolian angels.

The life of the College has not been disturbed by any startling events. We wish we could give better news of Mr. Watt; he is still living at St. Leonard's, but his health has not been good during the past year. Mr. Abbott is quite well again, but he has expressed a wish to be relieved of the burden of the senior tutorship. Yielding to the entreaties of the Society he has consented to remain a tutor for one more year, but he is relinquishing some of his work. Mr. Sinker has now become a tutor.

Both in scholarship and in athletics the College has held its own. We had seventeen first-classes in June, and we believe that in two Triposes Jesus men headed the list. Several other honours have been won by Jesus men. In games we have done well all round, and we won the Ladies' Plate. The number of the men in residence seems to be stabilized for the present at about 270, which is the maximum for which we have accommodation; it is, of course, matter for speculation whether in the face of bad trade and a declining birth-rate the present pressure will be maintained.

Mr. Mills, who generally figures in this report, has recently been nominated to the University Readership in Stereo-Chemistry.

Mr. M. P. Charlesworth, late Fellow of the College, has relinquished the tutorship of St. John's and become Laurence Reader in Classics

(Ancient History). Another ex-Fellow, Mr. W. B. R. King, has been made Yates-Goldsmid Professor of Geology in the University of London. Dr. Nairne recently received an Honorary D.D. at St. Andrew's University.

Among junior residents, S. F. Allison won a Jermie Septuagint Prize in the Michaelmas Term. R. V. Gittings won the Chancellor's Medal for English Verse, and T. F. A. Ragg was honourably mentioned. An achievement of a different kind was that of G. P. Fairbairn who, in the early part of the year, flew his own aeroplane back to Australia, landing at Port Darwin on April 18th. J. J. S. Garner and G. H. Williams, scholars of the College, won places in the Home Civil Service last autumn; C. A. Sharp, and W. G. Kennedy appeared in the Indian Civil Service list; and E. C. G. Barrett and E. B. David were granted Eastern Cadetships. P. Pares was among the first nine candidates for the Consular Service.

An appointment which attracted some notice in the Press was that of A. A. Ferguson, as Chief Constable of Northamptonshire. Mr. Ferguson came to Jesus from the Royal Naval College, Dartmouth. He then served with the Queen's Own Cameron Highlanders in India and Burma, resigning his commission to join the Edinburgh Police Force as a Constable. At the time of his appointment in Northamptonshire he was 27.

The Rev. H. B. Salmon has been appointed Principal of Wells Theological College, and Residentiary Canon of Wells Cathedral.

F. J. Middlemist, for 30 years Headmaster of All Hallows School, Honiton, has just retired.

He is succeeded by another Jesus man in D. B. Briggs, M.A., F.I.C., F.G.S., Housemaster at Bradfield College.

In July news came that the body of Arthur Conway Osborne Morgan, son of the late Master, who was reported "wounded, missing and believed killed" in 1915, had been discovered by French peasants near the Hohenzollern Redoubt.

Much sympathy is felt with Dr. Foakes-Jackson in the death of his wife which occurred in America last April. Dr. Foakes-Jackson has recently enriched the College library with nearly thirty volumes handsomely bound in red leather, which represent his published works. Mr. Brittain, who has now become librarian, is endeavouring to collect works by Jesus men, and it is the hope of Dr. Foakes-Jackson that his example in presenting his own books to the College will be followed by others. A list of publications will be much welcomed by the Librarian, who is at work upon a bibliography of books by members of the College. He is also trying to secure a complete set of Chanticlere. If any old Jesus man has a copy of the number for 1900, Mr. Brittain will be very glad to receive it.

The Jesus College Boys' Club in Camberwell is doing well under the leadership of Mr. J. D. E. Kellock, one of the residents at Cambridge House. About forty boys came down on Whit-Monday and spent an intensely happy day. The Club is increasingly well supported by resident undergraduates, and a number of old Jesus men continue to subscribe.

The College has some sixteen livings in its gift, and when these livings fall vacant considerable difficulty is often experienced in finding the right man for the parish. A patronage committee has recently been formed to keep in touch with the parishes, and with old Jesus men who have taken Holy Orders. It would help the committee if Jesus men who would like their names to be considered for College livings would inform the Master. Notices of vacancies will then be sent to them. A list of the livings in the gift of the College may be found in "Crockford."

Last year we had to record the death of James Hoppitt, for many years Head Porter. During the last twelve months two of the under-porters have retired, Milburn ("Curly") and Hones ("Tom"). Their places have been filled by ex-sergeants of the Marines, of whom we now have four in the service of the College.

Obituary

Just before the annual dinner came the news of the death of Charles Gurdon, Treasurer of the Society, and one of its most devoted members. He came up from Haileybury in 1874, and gained his blue for rowing and also for Rugby football. He rowed against Oxford for the four years 1876-79, played in the XV in 1877, and was an English international from 1880-1886, sometimes described as the best forward England ever had. He took his degree with honours in the Classical Tripos, and then studied law, being called to the bar in 1881. He became a Bencher of the Inner Temple in 1913, and was County Court Judge for Cornwall from 1923 to his retirement in 1929. Judge Mulligan writes "Gurdon was a sound lawyer as well as a great oarsman. His kindness was great. Many and many a one will say of him 'It is good to have known him, for all who knew him loved him.' None named him but to praise." Mr. Steve Fairbairn recalls some of his triumphs—"He won the 'Varsity Fours in four successive years, and at Henley won the Visitors' and Stewards', the Ladies' Plate and the Grand. He was a very good cricketer, but he sprained his ankle one term and so took to rowing. It was always said that but for the ankle he would have got his blue for cricket. Gurdon's character was wonderfully charming, and in his early days as a barrister he was possibly London's most sought-after bachelor; but he was absolutely the same to

everyone, even to the girls, for he never married." The College has lost a distinguished and generous son.

Known to an even wider circle in the athletic world was S. M. J. Woods who died earlier in the year. An Australian by birth, he came up to Jesus from Brighton College in 1886, and got his blue for cricket in his first year. In 1888 he played for Australia in a Test Match. At Rugby football he represented the University in 1888, 1889 and 1890, and played for England in many international matches between 1890 and 1895. He was Captain of England in 1892-3. His later triumphs as Captain of the Somerset County Cricket Club are too well remembered to need a detailed record. For many years "Sammy" Woods was one of the most popular figures in the cricket world. To quote from *The Times*, "He was never tired and never beaten, ever happy and care-free; to have played cricket with 'Sammy' in his golden prime is to have lived in happy days, and to have learnt the real meaning of courage, strength and cheerfulness." The Fellows of the College still remember an evening about ten years ago when Woods dined in Hall, and entertained them till a late hour with varied reminiscences. But it was the Cambridge *Daily News* which told how in his undergraduate days Woods invited five members of C. I. Thornton's eleven to breakfast in College. The fare provided was seven hot lobsters and strong ale, of which the visitors politely declined to partake. Sammy and MacGregor cleared the decks, after which Woods took all ten wickets at Fenner's. During the war Woods served in the

Somerset Light Infantry. On one occasion in the Dardanelles the Hindu stokers of his transport were overcome by the heat. Woods called for volunteers, and with seven men stoked the boilers for six hours. He was the last to give in. His reminiscences appeared in 1925.

P. W. Atkin, who died in February, came up from Mill Hill School, and was prominent in the golden decade of Jesus rowing. He rowed Head of the River for five years, and for the University in 1881, 1882 and 1883. In 1882 "Steve" rowed for the first time, and the stroke of the University boat was Stanley Smith, one of the "Cambridge Seven" missionaries, whose death was announced on the same day as that of Atkin. He was called to the bar in 1883, and became well known on the Northern Circuit. In 1913 he was appointed Stipendiary Magistrate for Salford. During the war, in which he lost his only son, Atkin served as Chairman of the Manchester Munition Court, was arbitrator in the Manchester Ship Canal dock strike of 1916, Chairman of the Salford Tribunal, and Chairman of the Moorlands Hospital, Kersal. He was made O.B.E. in 1918.

The Reverend G. Maxwell Edmonds died on December 28th, 1930. Edmonds, who came up in 1873, rowed in the Head of the River crews of 1875, 1876 and 1877, and in the winning crews of the Ladies' Plate in 1876 and 1877. He was spare man for the University in 1877, the year of the dead heat. For some years he coached the College crews. He was Rector of Stoke Doyle from 1885-1903, and Vicar of Stoke Golding from 1903 to the time of his retirement.

Dr. E. S. Verdon died in April. After graduating at Cambridge he took service about 33 years ago with the Sultan Mulai Abd el A'ziz of Morocco, whose fortunes he followed till the end of his reign. Subsequently he served the Sultan Mulai Hafid, and continued until that Sultan's abdication. "His abilities as a doctor and the kindness with which he used them, no less than his most genial social qualities, made him one of the most valued members of that strange community."

The Reverend T. Layng died last September. He came up from Oundle as a scholar in 1880, and took second classes in the Classical and Theological Triposes. For some years he was Assistant Master at the Surrey County School, and in 1893 he became Headmaster of Roysse's Grammar School, Abingdon. Later, he held the College living of King's Stanley.

The Reverend Canon T. Errington Scott came up in 1872, after spending some years in business. He was 34 years Vicar of Norton, Stockton-on-Tees, and in 1908 was made honorary canon of Durham. He died on October 9th, 1930, at the age of 87. Both Layng and Scott had sons at Jesus.

Roger Gould came up in 1911 from Christ's College, New Zealand. He rowed in the first boat, and during the war held the rank of Captain in the R.F.A. He died in New Zealand last autumn.

Herbert Gurney Goldsmith, youngest son of the Rev. H. D. Goldsmith, of the C.M.S., died on November 24th, as the result of a motor accident.

H. S. Whalley-Tooker, who died on April 12th at Hinton Daubnay, Hants, was educated at

Winchester and Jesus. From 1900 to 1907 he was Master of the Hambledon Hunt, and for 19 years he had his own harriers. He took a prominent part in the life of the county. He was for many years Chairman of the Catherington Rural District Council, and was senior acting magistrate for Hampshire until his retirement in January last.

His Honour Judge Muir Mackenzie died suddenly at Dar-es-Salaam on June 3rd, 1931, aged 49. He came up to Jesus from St. Paul's School in 1901, and was called to the bar by the Middle Temple in 1907, when he published a book on the Public Trustee Act. In the war he served in the H.A.C., in the Royal Munster Fusiliers, and on various staffs, being granted the rank of Captain on demobilization. In 1919 he was appointed Crown Counsel, Nairobi District, and acted as Solicitor-General in British East Africa. In 1922 he was transferred to Fiji as Attorney-General, and acted there on various occasions as Chief Justice. In 1927 he returned to East Africa on appointment to the High Court of Tanganyika Territory.

F. W. Welldon came up as a Rustat Scholar and took a second in the Classical Tripos in 1883. He was for 31 years an assistant master at Uppingham.

P. F. Tindall took his degree in 1879. He was Vicar of Folkestone from 1914 to 1926, and from 1898 had been an honorary canon of Canterbury.

W. C. Streatfeild was up just after the war. He rowed in the second May boat, and for the Remenham Cup at Henley Peace Regatta in 1919.

We note also the death of Malcolm Roberts, who was up from 1877 to 1882.

Thomas Jiggins died on May 30th. He became Butler in 1873, and only retired on a well-earned pension in 1928. His short upright figure was familiar to many generations of Jesus men, and by his excellent book-keeping and strict attention to business he was able greatly to extend the services of the Butlery. He was the last of a family which, ever since the 18th century, had been in the service of the College.

Time would fail to tell of the *Wheatsheaves* (membership much the same) and of the *Roosters* (membership quite different). The *Roosters* are beginning to absorb the dons, and Mr. Manning and Sir Arthur Quiller-Couch have been elevated to the Senior Perch of the Red Herrings, or something of the kind.

A new Society is the *Nomads*, which plays golf.

The *Musical Society* gave us a May Week Concert, which was well attended and much appreciated, and during the year numerous

concerts have been held in the Hall, the Master's Lodge and the Chapel.

BOOKS *The Christian Religion*. (Cambridge University Press, 3 vols., 7/6 each, General Editor, J. F. Bethune Baker, D.D.) In these three volumes our present Dean, with a number of distinguished collaborators, has endeavoured to provide a modern account of the origin, growth, and purpose of the Christian Church. The volumes, which are obtainable in nine separate parts, were originally planned as a contribution to the difficult problem of religious teaching in schools, but they will be found useful by all who desire an elementary introduction to modern theology. Volume II, which deals with Church History, is entirely the work of Jesus men.

Everyman's Story of the New Testament, by Alexander Nairne, D.D. (Mowbray). Dr. Nairne has now published the companion volume to his *Story of the Old Testament*. The new volume is written with the author's usual charm, and it is beautifully illustrated. There could hardly be a better introduction to the scholarly study of the Bible.

Fifty Years Against the Stream, by E. D. Tyndale-Biscoe. (Obtainable from Mrs. Long, The White House, Blofield, Norwich. 5/6.) A very interesting and amusing account of the famous C.M.S. School at Srinagar in Kashmir, of which the author's father, the Rev. C. E. Tyndale-Biscoe, has been Principal for forty years. Mr. Tyndale-Biscoe (senior) addressed a meeting in the College Hall on the first Sunday of last

term, and proved to have lost none of his vigour and humour.

Fairbairn of Jesus, by Steve Fairbairn, with a Foreword by Sir Arthur Quiller-Couch (John Lane). "A remarkable book by a remarkable man." This work has been extensively and appreciatively reviewed. So many old Jesus men must already possess it, that there is no need for us to say more.

Some Secrets of Successful Rowing, by Steve Fairbairn. (Sporting Handbooks, Ltd.) A new exposition of Fairbairnism. To quote the *Cambridge Review*, "In this book will be found pearls of wisdom extremely useful to all oarsmen, whatever their style."

Oar, Scull and Rudder: A Bibliography of Rowing. Compiled by F. Brittain, with a Preface by Steve Fairbairn. (Oxford University Press.) This remarkable book embodies much patient labour and research, and will fill a permanent place in the literature of sport.

South Mymms, by F. Brittain. (W. Heffer and Sons.) Our Librarian has shown what can be done in the way of research into the history of a little Hertfordshire parish. An instructive and entertaining book.

We hear that A. Lambton is publishing a new book, *Echoes of Causes Célèbres*.

ROWING We began the year by receiving the Michell Cup for the best all-round performance on the Cam during the year 1929-30.

As usual, we entered two crews for the coxswainless fours. Both were successful in the first round, the first four beating Selwyn and the second four beating Third Trinity II. In the second round,

however, the first four was beaten by Third Trinity I (the ultimate winners), and the second by Lady Margaret I.

The racing for the Fairbairn Cup was, as usual, managed by the J.C.B.C., no less than 40 crews, from 17 Colleges, taking part. Pembroke won the cup.

A. W. Anstey (bow) and C. D. Eberstein (coxswain) were given their Trial Caps by the C.U.B.C., in December, and P. N. Carpmael represented the College in the University boat for the second year in succession.

In the Lents, our first boat started third on the river, bumped Emmanuel on the third day, and finished second. The second boat bumped First Trinity II on the first day, and then rowed over, finishing eleventh on the river. The lower boats were less successful, the third losing one place and the fourth three places.

During the Easter vacation we again sent two eights to Putney to compete in the race for the headship of the Thames—another of Steve Fairbairn's foundations. There was a record entry of 125 crews, and our first boat finished second on the river, being defeated only by the London Rowing Club.

In the Mays our first boat lost the headship to Pembroke on the first night and rowed over on each of the following nights. The second boat stayed eleventh on the river. The third boat won its oars, and is now once more the highest third boat on the river. The fourth boat went down two places, and next year will have to fight the best of the getting-on boats to retain its place on the river.

At Henley we entered crews for the Ladies' Plate, Thames Cup, Visitors' Cup and Wyfold Cup. In the first round of the Visitors' we met First Trinity, who beat us by 4 feet after a good race. The Wyfold four, after an easy victory over Henley Rowing Club, was beaten by a length by First Trinity. In the Thames Cup, we beat Bedford Rowing Club by a length, but in the next round were beaten by the same distance by Lensbury.

Selwyn, our first opponents for the Ladies' Plate, were beaten by $1\frac{1}{4}$ lengths. On the following day we beat Eton by two lengths, and in the semi-final beat First Trinity by a length. In the final we beat Shrewsbury by $\frac{1}{3}$ -length, thus winning the Plate for the ninth time in our history. The members of the winning crew were : L. C. Shepherd (bow), 2, S. Hordern ; 3, J. C. McDouall ; 4, T. W. Reed ; 5, C. J. B. Palmer ; 6, P. J. Jepson ; 7, D. N. Thorne ; A. W. Anstey (stroke) ; C. D. Eberstein (cox). Four of these are second year men, and one (J. C. McDouall) is a Freshman.

"The regatta," said *The Times*, "was a triumph for Metropolitan oarsmanship and in particular for the Fairbairn style, for crews influenced by his teaching won every single event except the Diamond Sculls. Indeed, Cambridge orthodox rowing suffered an eclipse that was only overshadowed by that of Oxford rowing as a whole."

P. N. Carpmael rowed in the London crew which won the Grand, as did also another old Jesus man, A. J. Harby. The same pair, with Harby at stroke, rowed in the London four which won the Stewards' Cup. Three Jesus men who rowed in our May boat

last year—J. M. Fraser (5), F. T. Coulton (6), and D. H. Mays-Smith (7)—rowed in the London eight which won the Thames Cup.

A. W. Anstey has been Captain this year, with T. W. Reed as Secretary. The latter is to captain the club next year, with P. J. Jepson as Secretary.

CRICKET Exceptionally wet weather ruined the cricket season, which was the more unfortunate, since we had a very strong side. It was good to make Pembroke follow on. We had no blues, this year, and the melancholy happenings at Lord's showed how much Morgan and Killick were missed. Perhaps the University captain might have taken a longer look at some of our Jesus bats and wicket-keepers.

RUGBY FOOTBALL At long last we had a Rugger blue in C. H. Williams, who only just missed his blue last year. He has now left for Kenya, and we feel that the administration of one part of the Empire is in safe hands. Ohlsson was apparently safe for his blue when his knee gave way, so he has returned to South Africa with only first May colours and a University Trial Cap. The College team was the best we have had for some years. In the Michaelmas term we were only beaten by Pembroke, and in the Lent term we went right through to the final of the cup, defeating Pembroke on the way.

We won the University Six-a-side Competition, and retrieved the Inter-College Flag by beating St. John's. S. L. Baxter got his half-blue.

BOXING The College team won the Inter-College Competition as usual, and C. N. Godwin and P. Marx were awarded half-blues.

V. D. Hill was captain of the University swimming club, and G. E. Delafield won his half-blue for water polo. J. Bronowski represented the University at chess.

Annual General Meeting, 1931

The 23rd Annual General Meeting of the Society was held at the Café Royal, W., on July 6th, 1931. The Master of the College took the chair. The minutes of the last meeting were confirmed and the accounts passed.

The Hon. W. Justice Luxmoore was elected Hon. Treasurer in place of the late Judge Gurdon. Dr. Henry Menzies was re-elected Hon. Secretary.

Annual Dinner, 1931

The 30th Annual Dinner was held at the Café Royal, Regent Street, W., on Monday, July 6th, 1931. W. C. A. Elliott, Fellow of the College, presided. There were 86 old Jesus men present. In reply to the toast of the College the Master responded and gave an account of happenings at the College during the past year.

Jesus College Club for Boys in Camberwell

The Club has made considerable progress during the past year. The membership has grown to about fifty, and our subscription list is well maintained.

Our headquarters are still at Cambridge House, where the boys meet four nights a week during the winter. Football and cricket teams are run, and have had a good deal of success. There is a summer camp, and a Christmas dinner. Not least important are the visits to Cambridge. Twice during the past year the Club has been up to the College; there have been football and cricket matches, and substantial entertainment has been provided.

Mr. P. Maitland has been Secretary at Cambridge, and it is to his energy and initiative that most of the progress made has been due. He has been succeeded by Mr. F. H. Brain, who is working on the same lines. A College Committee over which the Master presides meets every term.

We are still in need of a Jesus man to take charge. Up to the present the Club has been managed by Mr. Davies, of Clare, to whom we owe a great deal; but in the coming year we shall not have his help; and although a Committee of Cambridge House residents are undertaking the management, and we have an invaluable N.C.O., we should feel happier if we could hear of a Jesus man living in London who would take over the main responsibility. Or perhaps three or four would give up an evening a week each.
